▲ The WR250Z's engine performance has been increased with the addition of: a new ceramic composite plated cylinder for longer wear, less weight and greater heat dissipation. A longer stroke for increased engine displacement (from 246cc to 249.5cc). A redesigned exhaust pipe, new port timing and a new YPVS valve shape. A new ratchet-type shifter provides lighter, smoother shifting under the most demanding conditions. New gear ratios, better suited for a broad range of terrain, and a lighting coil complete the package.



◀ The new computer designed Deftabar swingarm offers light weight with increased rigidity, while the new rear link ratio and shock absorber valving provide a great ride for closed course off-road competition. The WR250Z also features an 18 inch rear wheel.
